RVA will be experiencing its biggest staff turn-over ever. It has been neat to see how God has been filling all of the "holes" left behind by leaving staff. Even though some jobs have seemed impossible to fill in such a short time, God has always had a plan. It will be challenging to have so many new people on staff, but we are looking forward to fresh new ideas as well.

That being said, we, including Africa Inland Mission the organization we are with, are concerned about our financial support level. It is not adequate at this time which means that in the next few weeks we may have to consider postponing our departure. This is an incredibly disappointing thought to us as we feel so called to RVA and we have no back up plans. We trust God entirely to provide what we need. We do need to let you know though that at this time the need is great. We are fully preparing to go but we cannot continue with our current departure date until we have **100%** of our monthly support committed to. However, since January of this year we have been averaging 60% of our support. Currently we have **80%** of our support committed to for the next three years. AIM has extended our original deadline of July 20th to the end of the month, **July 31st**, as the new deadline to have this amount or we will have to change our departure date to a later date. If you would like to support us financially then follow the steps at the end of this letter. Please consider joining us in this way. When you do we would appreciate your commitment to start as soon as possible so that when **July 31st** comes we will not have to consider delaying our departure.
